The United States Federal Reserve Police serve as the law enforcement arm of the Federal Reserve System and they are responsible for providing police protection for the Federal Reserve System which is the Central Bank of the United States. Our sworn law enforcement Officers provide 24/7 protection of Bank property, personnel and valuables at our landmark headquarters in lower Manhattan. Our FLETA Accredited (Federal Law Enforcement Training Association) Basic Law Enforcement Course (BLEC) consists of an intense, highly regimented seven week rigorous physical and academic training program that includes formal legal and law enforcement classroom, firearms and scenario based training and testing

Participants must be able to graduate the Academy having met all requirements to become a Federal Law Enforcement Officer of the Federal Reserve System. 248(q); Perform mobile patrols in marked and unmarked Federal Reserve Police emergency vehicles; Conduct diligent visual review and observation of all persons, vehicles and activity in the vicinity of posts or persons entering the facilities
